


# Windows 10 VPN Instructions


Click on windows Icon then click on **settings**



Then Click on **Network & Internet**




Next click on **VPN** and select **Add a VPN connection**




Fill in the fields as follows and click **Save**:


Select the newly created connection and click on **Connect**




Enter your Dolphinet Username and password and click **OK**




Now you should see the VPN connection being established




Once it's done, It should show that you are connected




After connection is created you may see the VPN connection displayed in the network connections when you click on the network icon at the bottom right of your Task Bar




Click on **Change Adapter settings**




Right-click on the VPN connection and select **Properties**



Select the **Networking** tab, select **IPV4** then click on **Properties**



Click on **Advanced**



Uncheck **Use default gateway on remote network** then click **OK** on each opened window to confirm and close them out.
